## I | DESCRIPTION

These awards are given to recognize students who have performed outstanding **community service** in the Japanese American community or who have made **personal sacrifices for others**.

Academic achievement is not a consideration for these awards.

## II | ELIGIBILITY

- You are a graduating high school senior residing in the Denver, Colorado Metropolitan area who is either an American citizen of Japanese ancestry or an American citizen whose legal parent(s) is/are of Japanese ancestry, **OR**
- You are a graduating high school senior of Japanese ancestry residing in the Denver, Colorado Metropolitan area who has a permanent resident status (INS documentation) in the United States, **OR**
- You are a graduating high school senior who has a parent who is an active member of: Brighton Japanese American Association, Denver Nisei Bowling Association, Fort Lupton Japanese American Citizens' League, Japanese American Association of Colorado, Japanese Firms Association of Colorado, Longmont Buddhist Temple, Mile High Chapter Japanese American Citizens' League, Nisei Veterans' Heritage Foundation, Simpson United Methodist Church, or Tri-State/Denver Buddhist Temples.



## III | REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS FOR THIS AWARD

## A. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Be prepared to provide a brief description of community service/personal sacrifice.

## B. VOLUNTEER HOURS TOTALING 40 HOURS

1. Download [Letters of Attestation](#) to be filled out with your volunteer organization.
2. Provide 1-2 [Letters of Recommendation](#) from an organizer of a volunteer program you've been apart of.
3. Upload the filled-out form in the Secure Application as a .PDF or .JPG. *(Tip: Scan document or take a legible picture on your phone. Download this easy-to-use, free app [TinyScanner](#) to turn your photo into a PDF for upload purposes.)*
